Saving the Files to Your Computer

Follow the steps below to save the files to your computer:

Step	Action
1	Unzip the file iPhone_iPad_Stencils_v1.0.zip to your computer

Loading the Stencils in Visio

Follow the steps below to load the stencil in Visio:



Step	Action	
1	Launch Visio	
2	When the New tab appears, click Blank Drawing under the “Other Ways to Get Started” template	
3	After the blank Visio document appears, under More Shapes , click on Open Stencil	
4	Browse to the location where you saved the Visio stencils on your computer:

5	Click the Open button	
	Result: The stencil shapes will be available to the left of your screen	
6	Drag the iOS UI Visio Shapes from the Shapes Panel to the Visio document

Creating a "Clickable/Interactive" PDF

You can use these stencils to quickly create a "Clickable/Interactive" PDF by using hyperlinks and saving your document in PDF format.

Follow the steps to create a Clickable/Interactive wireframe:

Step	Action
1	Create your wireframe in Visio, please note that the Visio document should be comprised of Multiple pages
2	Right-Click the item in your Visio document that you would like to add a Hyperlink to (such as an icon or button)
3	When the menu appears, click on Hyperlink Result: The Hyperlinks dialogue box will appear
4	Click File > Save
5	Click on the Browse button next to Sub-address 
7	Select the Page that you would like to Link to and the Zoom you would like to use  Tip: We recommend selecting " Page " for the Zoom setting
8	Click the OK button and Repeat this process for each item on your wireframe that you wish to make "clickable"

Saving Your Wireframe as a PDF

Note: You must save your document as a PDF in order for the links to work correctly.

Follow the steps to save your document in PDF format:







Step	Action
1	In Visio, click File > Save As > PDF
2	Click the OK button

Editing Labels

Most of the shapes included in your stencil have labels which can be edited.

Follow the steps below to edit the labels on your shapes:

Step	Action				
1	Drag a shape that has a Label onto your Visio wireframe				
	Double-click on the Label that you wish to Edit, and enter your new text				
	Below is a comparison how the label will look when the text is selected
